FCC ADOPTS DTV ENFORCEMENT ORDERS TOTALING OVER \$6 MILLION The Federal Communications Commission has adopted 11 enforcement orders related to the DTV transition. They included seven Notices of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture (NAL) for violations of its DTV labeling requirements. These requirements protect consumers from unknowingly purchasing television receivers incapable of receiving over-the-air digital programming, a Forfeiture Order and Further Notice of Apparent Liability and an NAL for digital tuner rule violations. Enforcement in this area, which restricts the importation and interstate shipment of analog-only televisions, helps protect consumers from purchasing televisions that cannot receive digital signals and two NALs for violations of its V-Chip rules. These rules ensure that consumers' television receivers are capable of adapting to changes in the content advisory rating system.

SBE and Focal Press will introduce their first co-produced book during the 2008 NAB Show in Las Vegas. **HD Radio Implementation** is written by Thomas R. Ray, III. HD Radio is the FCC-approved standard for high-definition digital radio. Currently, the only place individuals can become trained for an HD Radio conversion is through Harris Corporation's five-day course for \$995 plus travel/lodging. The new SBE/Focal Press book provides the same in-depth information for a fraction of the cost--an excellent value for any station budgeting a conversion. It covers the installation process, uses examples from real-life implementations and information not found in manufacturer's manuals. The book is available through the SBE Bookstore and other retail outlets.
